IM Skaugen signs vessel charters for African small-scale LNG

Norwegian shipowner IM Skaugen has signed long-term charter contracts for three of its multigas vessels, to be used in small-scale LNG-to-power operations in Africa.

The ten-year charter agreements are for two 10 Mcm and one 12 Mcm vessels. Under the terms of the agreement, IM Skaugen will provide shuttle/feeder services, floating storage support and the offloading of LNG “with a client sponsored by two existing gas fired power plants in Africa,” the company said this week.
