Jamaica awards EPC contract for Old Harbour LNG power plant

Spanish construction firm TSK and South Jamaica Power Company (SJPC) signed an engineering procurement and construction (EPC) contract last week to build a 190 MW LNG-fired power plant at Old Harbour Bay in Jamaica.

The construction of the USD 300 million turnkey dual-fuelled plant is due to start on 1 March, but commissioning is likely to slip from the original deadline of July 2018 to early 2019.
