Global LNG trade rises 5% to 258 mt in 2016 – IGU

Global LNG trade saw a 5% year-on-year increase in 2016, reaching 258 mt, according to the International Gas Union's (IGU) annual report on the LNG industry, published on Wednesday.

IGU's report contrasts with the view put out last week by LNG importers group GIIGNL, which reported that global LNG trade grew 7.5% in 2016 to 263.6 mt.
