ANALYSIS: Rouhani's election landslide boosts Iran's gas investment prospects

The landslide victory of Hassan Rouhani in Iran's presidential elections last Friday will be welcomed by the many foreign companies queueing up to participate in Iranian gas development and export – but change may not come immediately.

In what was effectively a two-horse race, moderate incumbent Rouhani secured a second term by winning 57% of the vote, averting the need for a run-off with his main challenger, hardliner Ebrahim Raisi, who managed only a 39% share.
