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Shell signs up for more Qatargas LNG volumes, unfazed by Gulf crisis

Shell has strengthened ties with Qatargas by signing a new LNG sales agreement for an extra 1.1 mt of liquefied gas per annum, in a clear sign that it is largely business as usual for the world's largest LNG exporting country and its partners despite the imposition of sanctions by neighbouring Gulf states.

The shipments will be delivered over the next five years under the terms of a new sales and purchase agreement (SPA) that begins in January 2019.
