Operations at key gas and oil facilities along the Gulf Coast remains hampered as "catastrophic and life-threatening" flooding and downpours continue in southeastern Texas and portions of southwestern Louisiana in the wake of Hurricane Harvey.

While it appears refineries were largely most affected, the full scale of the disaster remains unclear as Harvey – which has since subsided to a tropical storm – circles the Texas coast bringing along gale force winds and torrential rain expected...
