# US DoE seeks to tear up environmental rule book for small scale LNG exporters

The United States Department of Energy (DoE) has proposed new rules for small scale natural gas and LNG producers that would allow those seeking to export up to 140 MMcf/d to bypass the need for a full environmental impact assessment (EIA).

The department hopes the move will allow producers to tap smaller markets in Central America and the Caribbean – where demand for LNG to fuel electricity generation is expected by some analysts to grow as much...
