EDF is looking at potentially selling the entirety of its majority stake in the recently commissioned Dunkirk LNG terminal in a bid to raise much-needed funds to help strengthen its balance sheet.

Market sources said the French state-backed utility is hoping to raise around EUR 1 billion (USD 1.2 billion) by offloading up to its 65% share in the regasification facility, but a contractual wrinkle could ...
