Poland sweetens shale regulation as exploration optimism rises

Poland is overhauling its regulatory and fiscal regime to tempt shale gas operators back to its beleaguered, fledgling industry, following the departure of several international companies over recent years. The old terms and delays to new legislation have led to criticism of the Polish government – which is eager for development to accelerate – but visual_editor7% state-owned PKN Orlen now claims operators are happy with the proposed changes, which should be passed into law by the end of the year. Gas Strategies examines the changing environment for international energy companies and provides an update on what is still considered Europe's most promising shale gas prospect.
