# Construction crews begin Olympic race to lay Australia's Eastern Gas Pipeline

Three construction crews working with more than 95,000 tonnes of steel and 47,000 pieces of pipe have started building Australia's first major competing pipeline – the Eastern Gas Pipeline – in a \$97 million (AUD\$450 million) programme spanning just over 18 months. Duke Energy International (DEI) – owner, builder and operator – has promised that gas will be flowing by the time of the Sydney 2000 Olympics.
