Uruguay and Argentina seek partners for LNG scheme

Uruguay and Argentina today said they are pushing ahead with plans for a 25 MMcm/d LNG terminal. The scheme will be run as a joint venture between the energy company Ancap and electricity supplier UTE, both owned by the Uruguayan state, and Argentina's state-owned energy company Enarsa. The joint venture, with a projected budget of \$1 billion, will seek expressions of interest from potential partners by next Friday.
