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Japan boosts LNG imports by 9.5% to 34.68 mtpa on renascent demand

Japan, the world's largest LNG importer, has ramped up imports by about 9.5% in the first half of this year driven by growing demand based on economic recovery. LNG imports reached a record high of 34.68 mtpa in the first six months of 2024, up from 31.65 mtpa in H1-2023, official customs data revealed.



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
