EIA estimates world shale gas reserves at 6,662 Tcf

A new study commissioned by the US Energy Information Administration (EIA) across 32 countries assessed technically recoverable shale gas resources at 5,760 trillion cubic feet (Tcf), compared with 862 Tcf in the US, bringing global reserves to 6,622 Tcf.
