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North Sea offshore drilling down by 25%

North Sea offshore drilling activity across the UK Continental Shelf dropped by 25% in Q1 of 2011, according to the North West Europe Review, which documents drilling and licensing in the area. Published by Deloitte's Petroleum Services Group, it revealed that five exploration and four appraisal wells were spudded in the UK sector in the first three months of the year, compared with 16 in Q4 of 2010.



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
