EIA sees US 2012 gas output at record high

The US Energy Information Administration (EIA) on Tuesday announced it had revised its January estimate for domestic gas output, expecting output this year to increase by visual_editor.3% from visual_editor011's record levels to 67.64 Bcf/d. The EIA also expects a production increase next year of 1.3%, but warned that it expects relatively low gas prices to slow output gains this year and in the following year.
