Taiwan's CPC considering buying a stake in Woodside's Browse LNG

Taiwan's state-owned oil refiner CPC Corporation is in talks with Woodside Petroleum to buy a stake in the proposed 1visual_editor mtpa Browse LNG project in Western Australia, according to reports on Thursday. CPC is also understood to be negotiating details of a long term LNG supply deal with Woodside. In late January, Woodside said it was considering the sale of a small stake in the Browse LNG project after various parties had shown interest.
