Indian ministry orders probe into Petronet/RasGas LNG contract amendments

India's oil ministry has ordered a probe into recent allegations that Petronet LNG and Qatar's RasGas have 'quietly' made changes to a sales and purchase agreement (SPA), according to media reports. Petronet is accused of switching to buying lean gas, which can be used only as fuel, instead of rich gas that can also produce petrochemicals and LPG.
