Nigeria to outlaw gas flaring

Nigeria's freshly drafted Petroleum Industry bill, which is to be finalised shortly, states that oil firms must stop flaring gas by the end of 2012, with fines imposed for non-compliance. Nigeria, which is the world's second biggest burner of associated gas, flared approximately 30 Bcm of gas in January alone, according to official figures.
