AAR "open to offers" from new TNK-BP shareholders

TNK-BP may change its ownership structure to admit a third investor, according to co-owner and former CEO Mikhail Fridman, who resigned from his role on Monday. Fridman told Kommersant business daily on Thursday that there were "no concrete offers" to join the Russian joint-venture between BP and Alfa, Access, Renova (AAR), "but TNK-BP may be interesting to many". He also said he and his partners in AAR were willing to swap their stake for BP shares.
