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Share of gas in UK electricity production at 14-year low – DECC

The proportion of gas in UK electricity generation fell to 9% during the first quarter of 2014 – its lowest share in the last fourteen years – due to high gas prices, while coal accounted for 41%, the Department of Energy and Climate Change (DECC) said on Thursday. Gas imports also decreased by 6.3% to 169.6 Twh compared to Q1 '11, with LNG imports accounting for 33% of the total figure.



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
