# Turkey and Pakistan seek increased Iranian gas imports

Turkey is seeking to increase natural gas imports from Iran, while Pakistan wants to start importing Iranian gas at a higher level, the managing director of the National Iranian Gas Company (NIGC) Javad Owji announced on Friday. Owji said Turkey had requested an additional 4-5 MMcm/d, up from 30 MMcm/d, while Pakistan was seeking to increase its contracted imports from visual\_editor3 MMcm/d to 30 MMcm/d.
