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Shell expands LNG Canada plans to 24 mtpa

Shell and partners KOGAS, Mitsubishi and PetroChina have unveiled plans to potentially double the size of their proposed LNG export project near Kitimat, British Columbia. The companies applied to Canada's National Energy Board (NEB) on Friday to export 24 mtpa of LNG for 25 years from a four-train project, with deliveries starting in 2019, opening up the possibility of a major future expansion of the scheme.



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
