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Does North Gateway oil approval signal new future for Alberta gas?

It might be an oil project but the approval of Enbridge's North Gateway scheme in Alberta is attracting a great deal of interest from the LNG world. The proposed 1,177 mile (2,860 km) pipeline and terminal has received the go ahead from the Canadian federal government to transport up to 525,000 barrels of light and heavy crude from Alberta's oil sands to a new super-tanker port at Kitimat in British Colombia.







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
