Japanese utility Kansai Electric Power (KEP) has acquired a 1.5% stake in the Ichthys LNG Project from INPEX Corporation. The equity interest includes a participating interest in both production licences for WA-50-L - Ichthys gas-condensate field - and WA-51-L, as well as an exploration permit for WA-52-P, the site adjacent to the condensate field.
