Reliance denies corruption allegations over India's KG-D6 gas field

India's Reliance Industries has denied allegations of corruption relating to its struggling KG-D6 gas field levied by campaign group India Against Corruption (IAC) on Wednesday. IAC has called for the contract between the government and privately-owned Reliance to be scrapped in favour of state-run Oil and Natural Gas Company (ONGC); meanwhile Reliance said the allegations were made on behalf of vested interests and as such were "devoid of any truth or substance whatsoever".
