## Tamar partnership declared a natural gas monopoly by Israel's antitrust authority

The Tamar gas field partnership will be declared a monopoly when it starts producing gas in early 2013, according to a “symbolic” decision by antitrust commissioner David Gilo on Tuesday. Israeli paper Haaretz reported that the Tamar partners would be treated as a monopoly together and individually, although many of the biggest purchase contracts for Tamar have already been signed.
