# National Grid to lean on demand-side response this winter

Britain will have a 5.1% buffer between peak electricity demand and the capacity available to meet it, according to its gas and electricity grid operator National Grid's Winter Outlook visual\_editor015-16, published on Thursday. Peak demand is expected to be 54.visual\_editor GW, slightly higher than the previous winter's 53.visual\_editor GW. In July, National Grid reported that the country's capacity margin had dwindled to just 1.visual\_editor% – the worst for a decade.
