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US regulator clears Magnolia LNG project to pursue export licence

The US Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) has thrown out objections by environmental group Sierra Club and upheld its approval of the proposed 8 mtpa Magnolia LNG plant in Louisiana.

The decision clears the way for the export project to proceed to seeking an export licence to countries without a free-trade agreement with the US (non-FTA) from the US Department of Energy.







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
