Maersk to decommission Denmark's largest gas field

Maersk Oil has unveiled plans to decommission Denmark's largest offshore gas field Tyra, as production has become uneconomical, the company said this week.

"We have not yet found an economically viable solution for full recovery of the remaining resources in the Tyra field, and safe decommissioning of Tyra will therefore be commenced with the perspective of ceasing production on 1 October 2018," said Maersk CEO Martin Rune Pedersen.
