Second US LNG bunkering facility nearing summer start-up in Florida

The US' second purpose-built LNG bunkering station, the Talleyrand depot in northeast Florida on the Atlantic coast, has received its storage tanks and remains on track to become operational later this summer, according to project developers Eagle LNG and Crowley Maritime Corp.

Once completed, the facility at the Port of Jacksonville will have around 850 tonnes of LNG storage capacity and should create a new value chain between the US and the Caribbean by selling gas liquefied at a local small-scale plant to ships bound for ...
