ANALYSIS: Chaotic UK election result throws Tory energy policies into doubt

The political uncertainty arising from the indecisive result of yesterday's UK general election has cast into doubt the ability of the ruling Conservatives to impose a cap on retail energy tariffs and pursue other energy policies pledged in the party manifesto.

The collapse in Conservative support led to a hung parliament and unconfirmed reports of an informal deal brewing with the Democratic Unionist Party (DUP) in Northern Ireland to prop up a slim two-seat Tory majority in the House of Commons.
