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Australia delays enforcing LNG export cap to 2018

Australia's federal government has delayed implementing sweeping controls on LNG exports until early next year.

Controls envisaged in the Australian Domestic Gas Security Mechanism (ADGSM), unveiled by Prime Minister Malcolm Turnbull in April, will not apply until 1 January – six months later than expected.
