Ghana's economy has grown rapidly in recent years but power supply has been unable to keep up with demand. Faced with power shortages, the west African country has sought an LNG solution to address this problem.

In mid-September, gas offtaker the Ghana National Petroleum Company (GNPC) signed a deal with the Tema LNG (TLNG) regas project, which could see Ghana begin importing LNG in 2019.
