# Golar questions BP's motives for declaring force majeure on Tortue FLNG vessel lease

BP has declared force majeure on its lease agreement with Golar LNG to delay completion of the 2.5 mtpa Tortue floating liquefaction (FLNG) project for a year until 2023, citing “business impacts due to Covid-19” – prompting a terse response from Golar. While the delay is ostensibly due to travel restrictions causing construction contractors to miss this year’s weather window, the news sparked speculation that ...
