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‘Blue hydrogen has a five year window’: Mark Lewis, BNP Paribas Asset Management

In July, the European Commission published its Hydrogen Strategy, which sets a goal of producing 10 mtpa of green hydrogen – manufactured without the use of fossil fuels – by 2030.
